Winter Activities at Golf & Country Clubs

We are seeing a large increase in planned Winter Activities at golf and country clubs across Canada and we must remind our Broker network that any activity outside of golf must be disclosed and approved by insurers in advance.

Insurers have always been very clear on this and they define all winter activities as a “material change in risk”. Without approval in advance golf courses may be leaving themselves exposed in the event of an incident on their property.

The increase in Slip & Fall lawsuits continues and in order to protect your golf customers please make sure that we are aware of all planned winter activities in advance.
